

Katumbi taught us to be kind and helpful to others.




We learned how to mold number 8 with play dough, and how to roll and make flower prints.

We tasted spicy ginger, sour lemons and sweet oranges.


We observed detailed pictures and looked for different objects.

Year 3 & 4



In English we have learnt all about conjunctions.
