At TPK we acknowledge hard work...celebrating our Class Dojo awards.

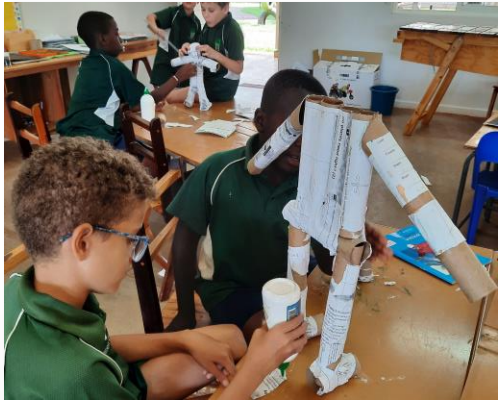
Book Character Dress up day was thoroughly enjoyed, and boys shared their reasons why they chose their specific character.
