We showed loved:

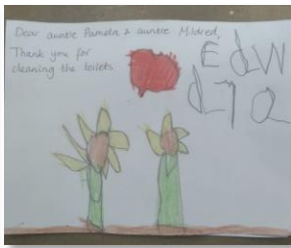
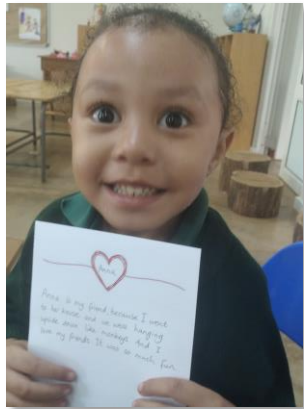
By making bracelets and giving them to our brothers, sisters and caregivers.

Receiving and sending messages of kindness makes us feel good!

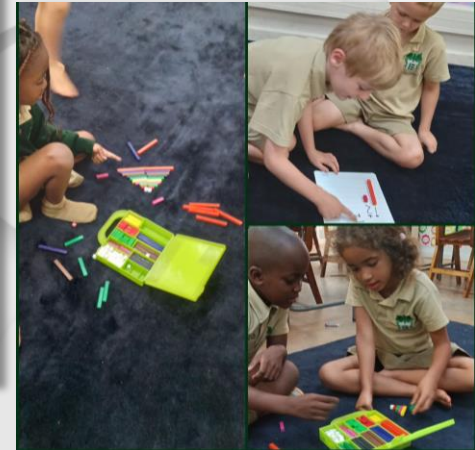
We can **see** our blood through a microscope!

We became scientists. We learned about white blood cells, red blood cells and platelets. We made a heart simulation and pumped the blood out of the heart, to all parts of our body.

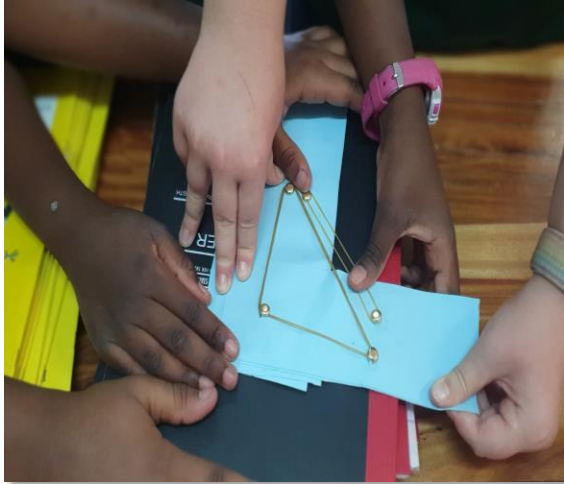
Year 1 & 2
